

STPPS High School Summer Session Credit Recovery Program Student/Parent Information and Contract

STPPS will be offering an online credit recovery program for students in grades 9-12 in the summer 2018 session. Students in Credit Recovery have the opportunity to regain credit for classes they have failed and thereby earn credits to fulfill requirements for graduation.

Students work on classes in the Odysseyware platform, a web-based, computerized curriculum aligned to the state standards. Parents and students can monitor progress in Odysseyware. Since participation in this program is voluntary, parental involvement is very important for student success.

Contract and payment due May 30. Payment should be made to STPSB in form of cashier check or money order. Cash and personal check will not be accepted.

Program Details:

Students will enroll in credit recovery courses with the high school guidance counselor. Coursework will be completed during the June session, and tests will be proctored on summer session test site campuses on scheduled test days (June 4-28).

- Who is Eligible for Credit Recovery? Students enrolled in grades 9-12 who attend a STPPS high school, and previously failed the same course are eligible to enroll.
- Can I enroll in an EOC/LEAP 2025 course? If you have passed the EOC/LEAP 2025 test for that course, yes, you are eligible to enroll.
- Where do I work on my courses? Students will work on the credit recovery course lessons at home. This means that the student must have access to an internet-connected computer outside the school campus. Students are required to take the Pretest on June 4th at Slidell High or Lakeshore High (summer session locations) at 9 am. Students must take the Posttest/Final test at the site on a scheduled test day and no later than June 28. Test days available are June 7, 14, 21, and 28.
- Will my failing grade be deleted from my transcript? No, the failing grade will not be removed from the transcript.
- What grade can I earn for the credit recovery course? Completion of credit recovery courses will earn a maximum grade of 67D for the course taken.
- How will my grade be determined? Students are required to demonstrate proficiency by earning a 67 on all lessons/tests in the course. Students will be given multiple attempts on all lessons and tests to earn the 67.
- Do I have to retake the entire course? No, students will take a Pretest which will determine the standards that the student has not mastered. The lessons assigned will be set based on the standards needing remediation. Pretest must be taken on June 4th at SHS or LHS at 9 am.
- How often do I have to log in to the online platform? There is no specific amount of time required per week but daily log in is expected.
- How long do I have to complete the course? This is a self-paced, individualized program; however, due to accountability issues, students must complete the course by the June 28, 2018.
- How many courses may I take? For the summer session, 2 courses may be taken in the June session.
- Is there a cost for credit recovery? Yes, the enrollment fee is \$50 per course.
