School information beginning September 14, 2020

School begins Monday, September 14 for Group A (Last name begins with A-K)
School begins Tuesday, September 15 for Group B (Last name begins with L-Z)

Please refer to the hybrid schedule posted for semester one of the 2020-2021 school year. Please note on which days students are to report. Schedule will be available online through the Student Progress Center portal.

General Precautions

- Safety of our students, faculty and staff is of utmost importance to us. All precautions and procedures are in place for the safety of everyone on campus.
- If your child does not feel well in the morning, please do not send to school.
- All back to school information is posted on the Covington High School website via the *Back to School* link.
- *Covington High School Student Handbook* is accessible via *Back to School* link on the CHS website.
- Dress code policy is located in the *Covington High School Student Handbook*.
- Masks must be worn at all times with the exception while eating or drinking
- Handwashing is required upon arrival, at least every two hours, before and after eating, after changing of classes, and before exiting to leave school.

- Sanitation stations for handwashing will be located throughout the school to supplement bathroom facilities.
- Hallways will be one-way traffic flow. Signs will be placed around campus to aid in traffic flow patterns. Refer to school map for traffic flow patterns.
- Shared water fountains will be closed. Students are encouraged to bring their own water bottles from home. Water filling stations will be available.

Morning procedures

- First bell to report to class rings at 7:24 a.m.
- Upon arrival to school, students must report to their 1st or 4th period classroom.
- Students are not allowed to gather in any areas of the school; they must report to their classroom.
- Health screening will be conducted.
- Students not meeting the screening requirements will be sent to the sick room and parents contacted for immediate student pick-up.
- Once health screening is complete and students are cleared, students are allowed to visit the cafeteria for grab and go breakfast. They will return to the classroom to eat breakfast.

Classroom procedures

- Masks must be worn at all times by students and teachers.
- Social distancing of students is required. Desks will be placed 6 feet apart, to the maximum extent possible.
- High-touch surfaces cleaned between classes.
- Teachers will establish classroom procedures aligned to Louisiana Department of Health and BESE safety guidelines to maximize safety.

Lunch procedures

- 3 separate lunches to meet social distancing guidelines.
- Disposable plates and utensils will be used.
- Designated entrances and exit flow paths established.
- Outdoor and indoor seating to limit capacity.
- Utilize MyPaymentsPlus to minimize physical contact with physical currency.

Afternoon procedures

- When dismissed, students are to report directly to their bus, car or to car line. Students will not be allowed loiter on campus and wait for rides.
